Nothing.

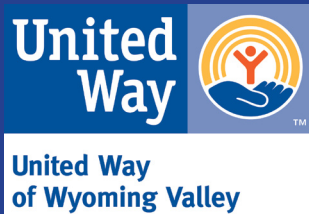
