BORN HEALTHY

New and expectant moms access home visitation programs to ensure healthy pregnancies, improved child health outcomes, and skilled and knowledgeable parents.

Children have access to basic health and developmental screening services.



KINDERGARTEN READINESS

Children arrive academically and developmentally ready for kindergarten.



READ AT GRADE LEVEL

Children are reading proficiently by the end of third grade and are on track for learning.

Wrap-around programs support safe homes, positive parent/child interaction, and promotion to the next grade.

Children improve readiness and early literacy through school-based support services.

Children maintain good school attendance with interventions to address chronic absenteeism.



HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

High school graduates are prepared for college, career, and life.

Youth participate in collaborative programs to help children envision a path from school to college or career and receive intervention services to ensure children do not fall behind.
